

JAMES ROBERTSON ARCHIVE

James Robertson and Alison Robertson (Pritchard) are very grateful for the support of Stewart Wallis, Executive Director of the New Economics Foundation (NEF), and for the essential work of Elna Kotze in preparing this archive. It has been a pleasure to work with her and we are privileged to continue to have our contact with NEF.

This archive starts in 1953 with James joining the UK Civil Service. He worked in the Colonial Office on a number of colonies including Mauritius and Seychelles. He accompanied junior Colonial Minister John Profumo as the first British Minister ever to have visited Seychelles. He was then chosen to accompany Prime Minister Harold Macmillan in 1960 on what came to be known as the "Wind of Change" tour of Africa.

He then spent three years in the Cabinet Office and was then transferred to the Ministry of Defence (which was being set up to co-ordinate various services between the navy, army and airforce.)

In 1965 he left the Civil Service and joined a computing and management consultancy called CEIR, from which he was head-hunted to set up the Inter Bank Research Organisation (IBRO). Those two organisations allowed him to use time to advise parliament and the government on various matters. He published his first book "Reform of British Central Government" in 1971.

When he left IBRO in 1973 he became self-employed. His activities included lecturing at the London School of Economics (LSE).

By 1983 he was able to play a leading part in TOES (The Other Economic Summit), which gave birth to the New Economics Foundation (NEF), with which he is glad to associate this archive.
